(Zones Approved as of May 1, 2023)**

Note: Feeder patterns provide detailed information on student advancement from one level to another within a particular attendance zone based on a residing address. This table shows the full hierarchy of student advancement starting with each high school and working ones way down by grade level. For example, Apopka HS has 684 residing students feeding into it from one grade level (K). Of those 684 students, 76 will be coming from Kelly Park School, 320 will be coming from Apopka MS and 288 from Wolf Lake MS. In addition, multiple elementary schools make up the feeder of those 320 Apopka MS students feeding into Apopka HS. A feeding school can be on this report multiple times if it feeds students within different high school hierarchies.
